



A THREE-WHEELED SPECIAL THERAPY BICYCLE

Some of you may know it: in August last year I had to go to the hospital for an appendectomy. After having recovered well in the first few days after the operation, I soon experienced severe complications which kept me for a total of seven months in the hospital, three of them in the rehabilitation clinic. Since March 17 I am back at home, but I have to learn to walk again - because of polyneuropathy. At home I can already walk with the handstick, outside I move with the walker.

As my **polyneuropathy** will persist for an indefinite period of time, because of which both feet are numb, which means that I am handicapped in my mobility, my doctor has prescribed a **three-wheeled special therapy bicycle**, in order to guarantee me greater freedom of movement and give me the opportunity to move independently and self-determined also outside my home. Since all external limbs are moved, this will also help strengthen or reactivate the nerve conducts in the sense of therapeutic training. My doctor expects that this would help me decisively in my physical and psychosocial recovery.

The health insurance company and the Social Welfare Office so far have refused me this bicycle, and I am dependent on help to **finance the high costs by my own**. It is the *Van Raam "Easy Rider"* model, equipped with an electric motor and other necessary extras, which I have adapted to my needs.
